# Trash & Recycling Instructions For Bridlewood HOA

### Dear Bridlewood Resident:

AAA would like to take this opportunity to thank you for letting AAA Recycling and Trash Removal service your community. AAA services your community for Trash, Recycling, Yard Waste Removal, and limited Bulk items. Please find below information to assist you with our service. ### Current Service Days:

Trash – Monday & Thursday

Recycling – Monday

Yard Waste – When prepared properly, please place with trash

Bulk Items – Thursday (must be scheduled previously by calling 703-818-8222)

### Equipment Provided

- AAA provides each home with one 96-gallon wheeled Trash Cart and one 18-gallon Recycling Bin upon request and no additional charge. Extra recycling bins may be ordered at no additional charge. Extra AAA Trash Cans can be rented for \$4.00 per month rental billed to the resident annually.

### Pick up Times for TRASH & RECYCLING

- Please have your bagged or containerized items placed out by 5:00 am on your service day.

### Special Items

- AAA will collect a small amount of furniture and other large, non-metal household items placed on the curb at no extra charge.
- All appliances (white goods) must be pre-paid and scheduled by the individual resident prior to removal. All appliances containing Freon (CFC's) must be tagged with certification that it is FREON-FREE prior to removal.

### We will NOT Pickup

Rocks, concrete, dirt, tires, soil, sod, tree stumps, paint, motor oil, construction trash/renovation debris, combustibles, toxic or hazardous wastes, or any other material excluded from the disposal site, or any applicable state or federal law, as being hazardous or toxic. As well as flammable products, dead animals, fecal matter, manure, brick, landscaping timbers, friable asbestos, lead acid/wet cell batteries, bio-hazardous material, needles, and other medical waste. Containers or bundles weighting more than 50 pounds or longer than 4 feet in length will not be collect as household trash. AAA's crews cannot collect debris that is too large or too heavy to be loaded safely into our vehicles.

### Single Stream Recycling Collection:

AAA will collect mixed paper, food/beverage glass and plastic bottles, food/beverage aluminum & tin, corrugated cardboard & fiber-board, all recyclables can be placed together. AAA provides one 18-gallon Recycling Bin, extras may be ordered upon request at no additional charge.

#### RECYCLING YES:

- Food & Beverage "SMALL NECKED" Glass & Plastic Bottles, #1 and #2 Plastic bottles and jugs
- Food & Beverage Tin & Aluminum Cans
- Mixed Paper: Junk Mail, Newspaper, Magazines Cereal Boxes, **Flattened Cardboard less than 3ftx3ft**
- Remove caps and lids and rinse out residue and place in recycling container, place at curbside by 5:00am

#### RECYCLING NO:

- Glass recyclables not acceptable are windows, drinking glasses, cups, plates, cookware, mirror, light bulbs, broken glass.
- Metal recyclables not acceptable are pots, pans, foil, pie tins, scrap metal.
- Plastic recyclables not acceptable "WIDE NECKED" tubs: yogurt, dairy containers, Styrofoam containers, clamshell food containers
- Not Acceptable is any recyclable that is contaminated with food, like Pizza boxes, Plastic or Aluminum "carry out" food tray
- Plastic film such as Grocery Bags and Dry Cleaning Bags are not recyclable within this program and considered a contaminant.

### Holidays:

AAA will provide removal of trash and recyclables on all holidays that fall on a regularly scheduled pickup day, with the exception of THANKSGIVING DAY, CHRISTMAS DAY and NEW YEAR'S DAY or when the facility chooses to close. When a designated pickup day falls on one of these holidays, uncollected trash or recyclables will be removed on the next regularly scheduled pickup day for that debris. Christmas trees will be collected the first two weeks of January. Trees must be placed at the curb prior to 6 a.m. All tinsel and ornaments must be removed from the tree. Please do not place in bags.
